What is the Kingdom of God?



- >The Kingdom of God is a spiritual, powerful realm that cannot be naturally perceived.
- >This literal, spiritual realm, is accessible to born again believers only.
- >The Kingdom of God is God's sovereign rule on earth through man, whom He calls a royal priesthood.

9 But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

10 who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.

“The Conceptualization of the Kingdom of God”

Conceptualize

To arrive at a concept or generalization as a result of things seen, experienced or believed.

1. The Kingdom of God is available only to the repentant.

Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death.

2 Corinthians 7:10 (NIV)

True Repentance Consist of:

- (1) A true sense of one's own guilt and sinfulness.
- (2) An apprehension of God's mercy in Christ.
- (3) An actual hatred of sin and turning from it to God.
- (4) A persistent endeavor after a holy life in walking with God.

2. The Kingdom of God Must



Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity.

1 Timothy 4:12 (NKJV)

2 The only letter of recommendation we need is you yourselves. Your lives are a letter written in our hearts; everyone can read it and recognize our good work among you.

3 Clearly, you are a letter Christ showing the result of our ministry among you. This "letter" is written not with pen and ink, but with the Spirit of the living God. It is carved not on tablets of stone, but on human hearts.
