



“Confess Sin”




*Confess your sins to each other and

James 5:16, NLT




Sin is any lack of

of God.




Conformity' is “not being or

the mark.”






1. Confession can often be scary
and shameful.




Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves coverings.

1 John 1:9, NKJV


II. The beauty of confession.
