Three Stages of Salvation

- I. Justification – Deliverance from the penalty of sin.**
- II. Sanctification (Holiness) – The process of Deliverance from the power of sin.**
- III. Glorification – Deliverance from all spiritual defects of the redeemed.**

Holiness/Sanctification

**Signifies separation—separation from
sin and consecrated to God.**

**It is the resulting state of conduct that
fits those who are separated unto God.**

Follow peace with all men, and
holiness, without which no man shall
see the Lord:

Hebrews 12:14 (KJV)

15 But now you must be holy in everything you do, just as God who chose you is holy.

16 For the Scriptures say, "You must be holy because I am holy."

1 Peter 1:15-16 (NLT)

1 Finally, dear brothers and sisters, we urge you in the name of the Lord Jesus to live in a way that pleases God, as we have taught you. You live this way already, and we encourage you to do so even more.

2 For you remember what we taught you by the authority of the Lord Jesus.

1 Thessalonians 4:1-2 (NLT)

3 God's will is for you to be holy, so stay away from all sexual sin.

4 Then each of you will control his own body and live in holiness and honor—

5 not in lustful passion like the pagans who do not know God and his ways.
