1. Disobedience

Disobedience involves choosing to act in a manner contrary to divine instructions or moral principles, often motivated by self-interest, pride, rebellion, or disbelief.

2. Ignorance and Closed-Mindedness

This wall embodies the refusal to consider alternative perspectives, new ideas, or unfamiliar truths. It stifles intellectual curiosity and spiritual growth.

3. Unbelief
