“HOW TO PRAY THROUGHOUT YOUR DAY”

“Pray in the Spirit AT ALL TIMES with ALL KINDS OF PRAYERS, asking for everything you need. To do this you must always be ready and never give up.

What does it mean to pray in the Spirit?

- It just means let God lead you.
- Follow the Spirit's leading.
- Listen to God's impressions.
- When the Holy Spirit puts an idea in your mind, stop and pray about it.

- **How do you pray without ceasing?**
- **How do you continually pray without stopping?**

- **There is no bad time to pray.**
- **There's never an inappropriate time to pray.**
- **Every time, anywhere, you can pray all the time.**
- **It's always a good idea to pray.**
- **Nothing is off limits.**
- **Pray with all kinds of prayer.**

Three Different Ways That You Can Pray Throughout Your Day:
