



to materialism.”**





Materialism is the attitude of someone who attaches a lot of importance to money and wants to possess a lot of material things.







The sixth *key* of “*The Treasure Principle*”



“God prospers me not to raise my standard of living, but to raise my standard of giving.”

kingdom to God's kingdom.


