Christian hope is *not compensation*.

We are not waiting for God to “make it up to us” by giving us mansions or streets of gold. God is going to transform our very bodies to bodies that cannot perish or die.

Christian hope is *not explanation*.

The bible does not tell the Corinthians that one day God will explain everything. Our hope is not grounded in the notion that one day we will understand everything. Our hope is grounded in the belief that one day everything will be made new!

Christian hope is *not* evacuation.

Heaven is a wonderful place where we find rest in the presence of God.

But even heaven, for the early Christians, was not the focus of Christian hope.
