




THINGS TO REMEMBER WHILE WAITING ON GOD

1. Remember there's a natural delay between planting & harvesting!




2. Remember there's an unseen battle going on.






THINGS TO REMEMBER WHILE WAITING ON GOD

3. Remember God is preparing me for His blessings.
