“Four Faith Facts”

I. Faith is Supernatural

***Now faith is the substance of things hoped for,
the evidence of things not seen.***

Hebrews 11:1, NKJV

Mark 1:40, NLT

41 Moved with compassion, Jesus reached out and touched him. "I am willing," he said. "Be healed!"

42 Instantly the leprosy disappeared, and the man was healed.

***II. Faith and Fear cannot
Occupy the same space.***

While He was still speaking, some came from the ruler of the synagogue's house who said, "Your daughter is dead. Why trouble the Teacher any further?"

"Do not be afraid; only believe."***
