Esther 6:10, NKJV

Then the king said to Haman, "Hurry, take the robe and the horse, as you have suggested, and do so for Mordecai the Jew who sits within the king's gate! Leave nothing undone of all that you have spoken."

Esther 7:3-4, NKJV

3 Then Queen Esther answered and said, "If I have found favor in your sight, O king, and if it pleases the king, let my life be given me at my petition, and my people at my request.

4 For we have been sold, my people and I, to be destroyed, to be killed, and to be annihilated. Had we been sold as male and female slaves, I would have held my tongue, although the enemy could never compensate for the king's loss."

Esther 7:5-6, NKJV

5 So King Ahasuerus answered and said to Queen Esther, "Who is he, and where is he, who would dare presume in his heart to do such a thing?"

6 And Esther said, "The adversary and enemy is this wicked Haman!"

So Haman was terrified before the king and queen.

Esther 8:15-16, NKJV

15 So Mordecai went out from the presence of the king in royal apparel of blue and white, with a great crown of gold and a garment of fine linen and purple; and the city of Shushan rejoiced and was glad.

16 The Jews had light and gladness, joy and honor.

Esther 8:17, NKJV

And in every province and city, wherever the king's command and decree came, the Jews had joy and gladness, a feast and a holiday. Then many of the people of the land became Jews, because fear of the Jews fell upon them.

Esther 9:2-3, NKJV

2 The Jews gathered together in their cities throughout all the provinces of King

Ahasuerus to lay hands on those who sought their harm. And no one could withstand

them, because fear of them fell upon all people.

3 And all the officials of the provinces, the satraps, the governors, and all those doing the

king's work, helped the Jews, because the fear of Mordecai fell upon them.

Esther 9:4-5, NKJV

4 For Mordecai was great in the king's palace, and his fame spread throughout all the

provinces; for this man Mordecai became increasingly prominent.

5 Thus the Jews defeated all their enemies with the stroke of the sword, with

slaughter and destruction, and did what they pleased with those who hated them.

10 “Hear, O Lord, and have mercy on me;
Lord, be my helper!”

11 You have turned for me my mourning into dancing;
You have put off my sackcloth and clothed me with
gladness,

12 To the end that my glory may sing praise to You and
not be silent.

O Lord my God, I will give thanks to You forever.
