Five Areas in Which the Man Should Lead

I. The Pursuit of His own Personal Relationship with God.

No man will be a spiritual leader in his home if he is not going deep with God in his own private life.

It's what we become in
solitude with God that makes
us spiritual leaders.

If we fail here, we fail utterly.

Five Areas in Which the Man Should Lead

II. He Answers the Call of Responsibility.

The Lord God placed the man in the Garden of Eden to tend and watch over it.

Genesis 2:15

❑ The husband should be a source of strength, security and love for his wife.

❑ He should have her respect.

❑ He is uniquely responsible in the relationship.

Men are too proud to admit that
spiritually they must play catch-up to
their wives.

So they just hang back and think of
the spiritual life as “woman’s work”
and protect their egos.

III. He takes the lead in shaping the moral and spiritual vision of the family.

You can't lead anyone anywhere until you have thoughts about where you want to go.
An aimless husband does not make a happy wife.

**Where there is no vision, the people perish:
but he that keep the law, happy is he.**

IV. He Lives A Lifestyle of Worship

V. He Models a Lifestyle of Obedience to God's Word.

 - Humility
- Compassionate
 - Merciful
- Longsuffering
 - Generous
