A Good Conscience

God has given every person a  
conscience to guard and guide  
them.



The Holy Spirit works through the conscience to remind us that some attitudes, thoughts, words, and actions don't fit our new identity in Christ.

The more committed we are to Him, the  
louder our conscience will be.

This is a warning to us that spiritual shipwreck eventually comes to those who feel the conviction of their conscience and reject its signals.

God gave us the conscience for our protection,  
but when we plow on through without obeying its  
counsel, eventually it is of no use to us.

The purpose of my instruction is that all believers would be filled with love that comes from a pure heart, a clear conscience, and genuine faith.
