



Dependence on God means we need Him, and we understand that without Him we are unable to accomplish anything of Kingdom significance.


# *The All-Sufficiency God*

Job 23:13, AMP




Many are the plans in a man's heart,


The Lord brings the counsel of the nations to naught; He makes the thoughts and plans of the peoples of no effect.

Come now, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to such and such a city, spend a year there, buy and sell, and make a profit";




