

Ephesians 2:8-10, (NKJV)


8 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God,

“In the first place, it is not our prayers that move the Lord Jesus, but the Lord Jesus who moves us to pray.”




We've turned prayer

John 6:65, (NKJV)


And He said, "Therefore I have said to you that no one can come to Me unless it has been granted to him by My Father."


