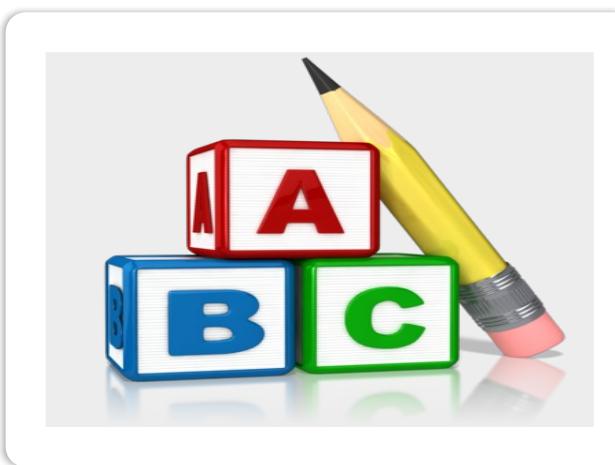

III. Overcoming Setbacks - something that reverses or delays progress; relatively minor “hiccups,” or speed bumps that slow you down.

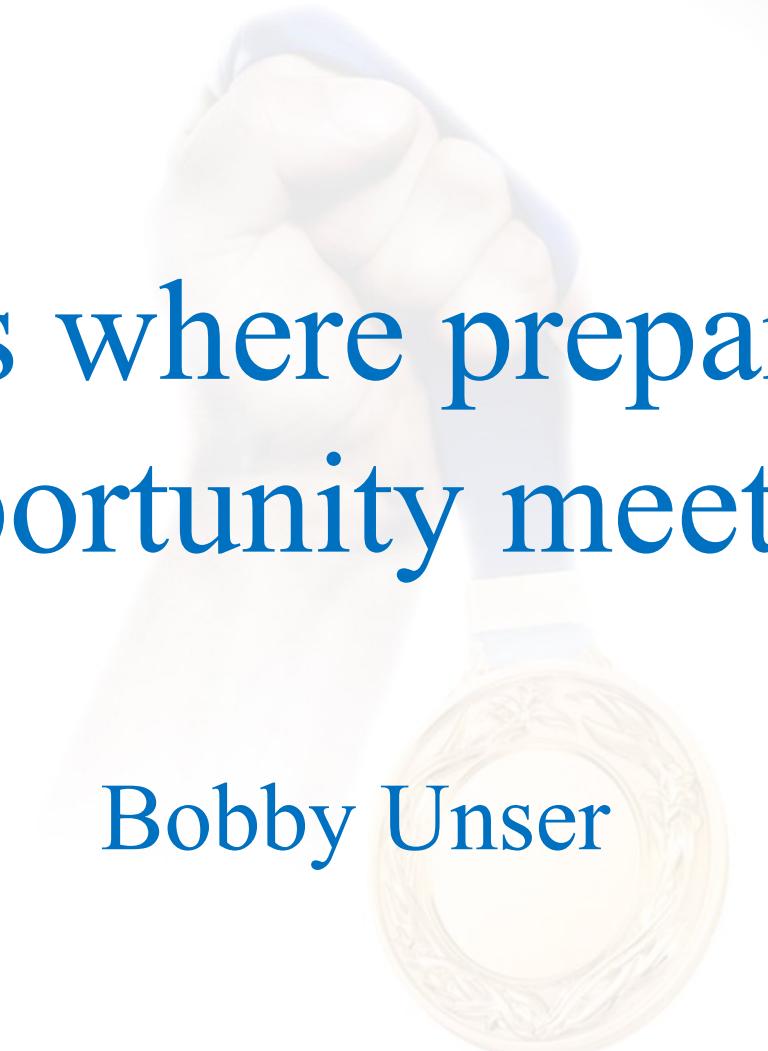

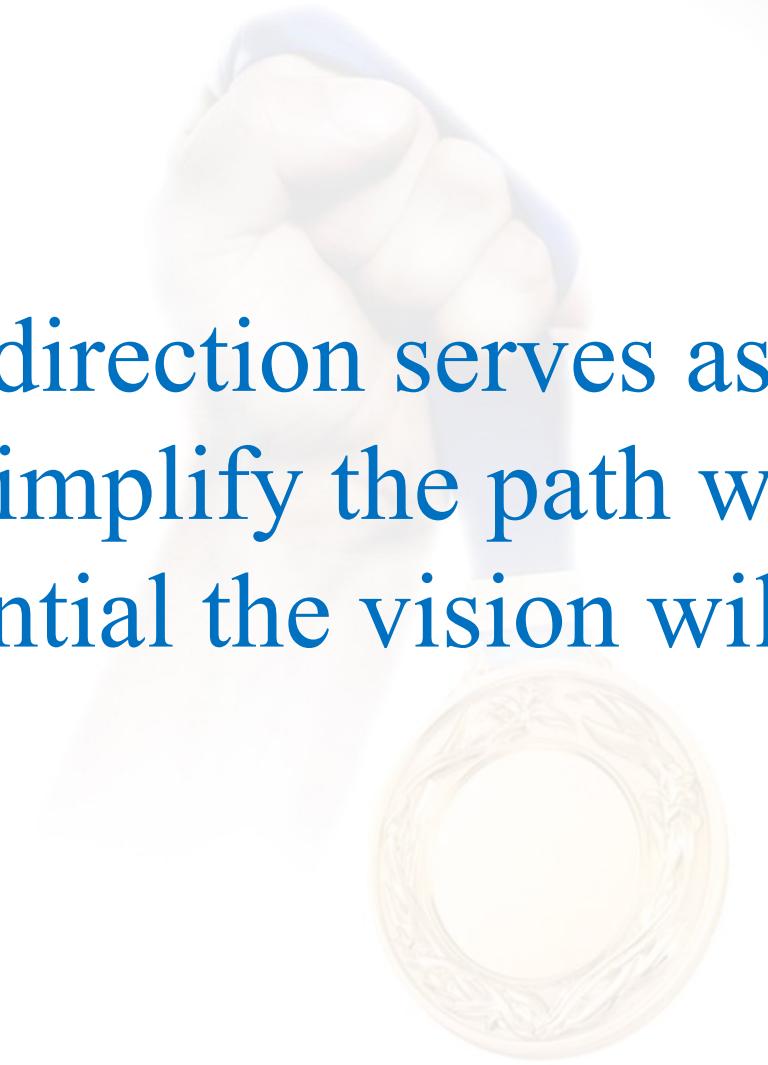

IV. Clear Direction - knowing how you're going to get where you want to go.





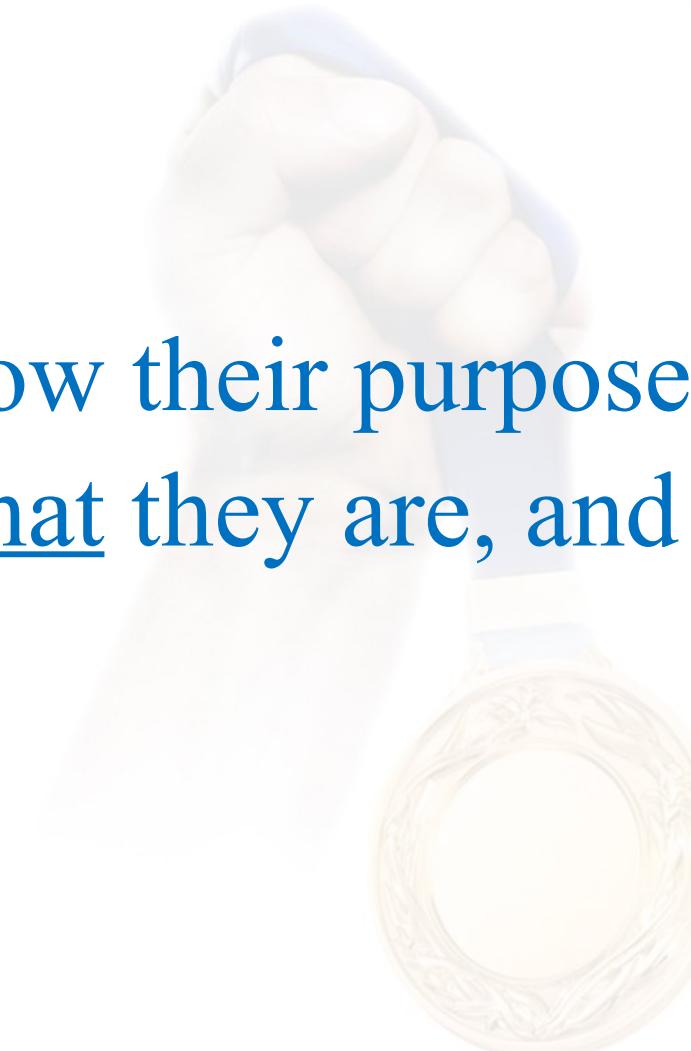
Having clear direction serves as a road map.
