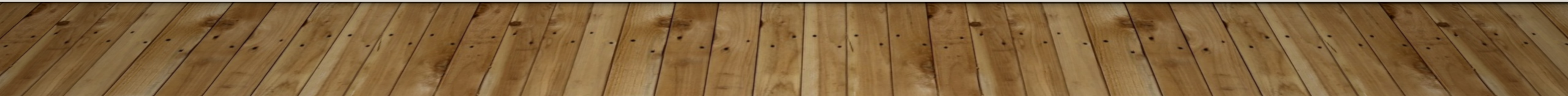
**“THE KINGDOM PARENT”**

Isaiah 3:4-5, NLT

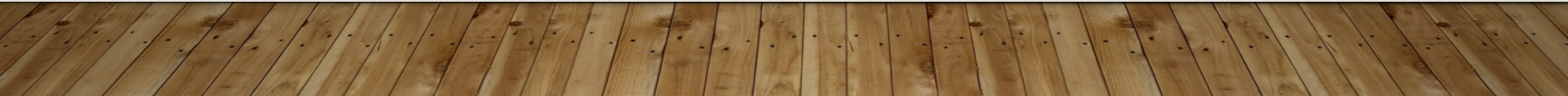


1 But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come:

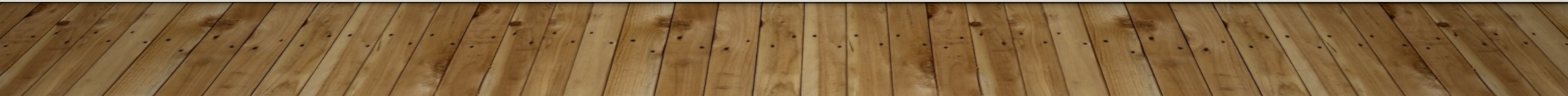
# 1. A STRONG KINGDOM FAMILY



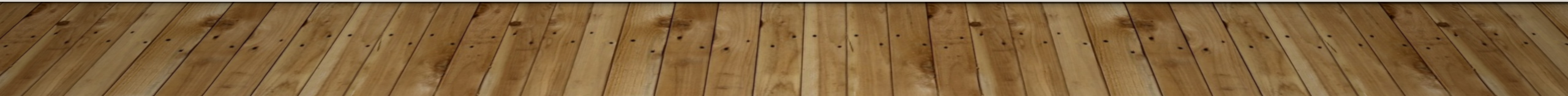
Then God said, “Let Us make man in Our image,

## 2. THE IMPORTANCE OF KINGDOM FATHERS

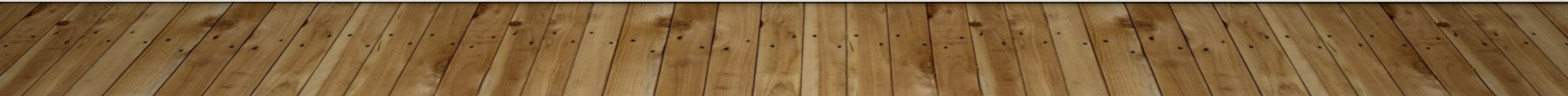




18 “For Abraham will certainly become a great and mighty nation,

will be blessed through him.

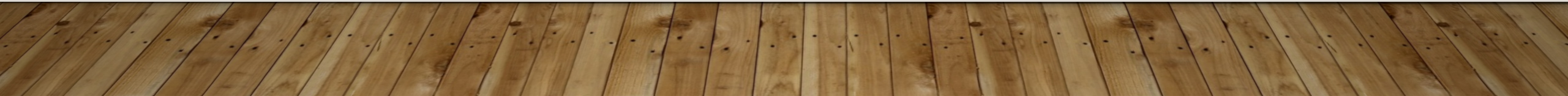
19 I have singled him out so that he will direct his sons and their

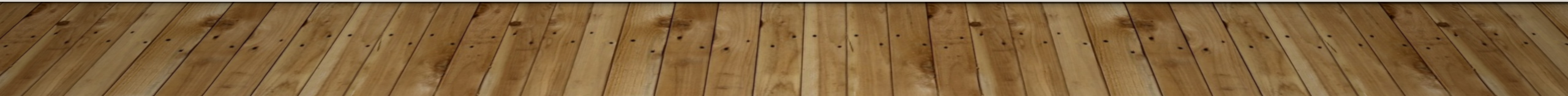

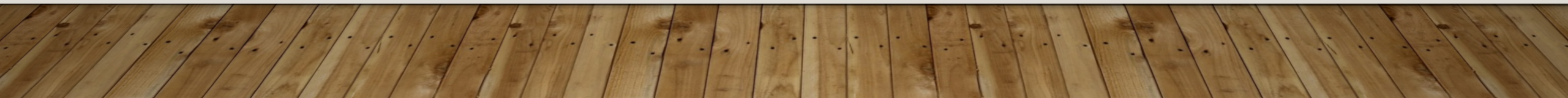


# 3. ENCOURAGE OUR CHILDREN



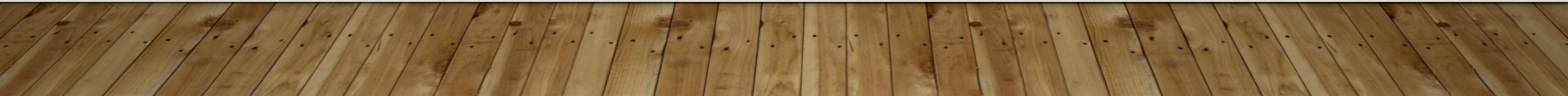
**“A parent who is not known for encouragement, but rather discourages their children speaks failure and curses into their future. Rather, as parents, we are called to give encouragement.”**

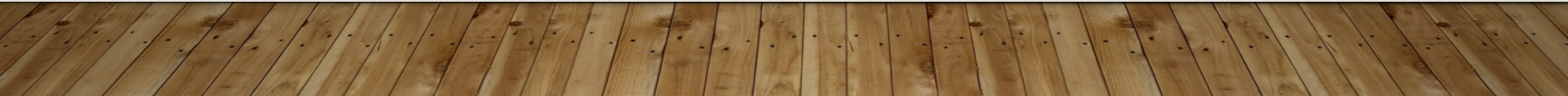
# 4. DISCIPLINE OUR CHILDREN

Proverb 22:6, NKJV

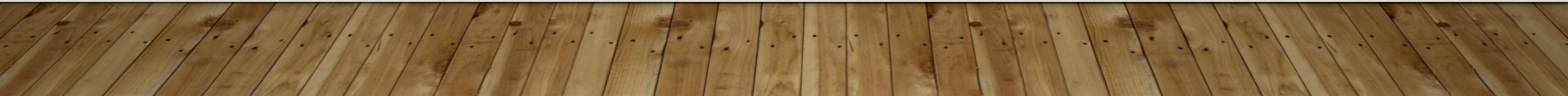
The rod and rebuke give wisdom,
