**12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God.**



**13 These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual.**

**14 But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.**

**1 Corinthians 2:13-14, NKJV**



- \* The word describes being able to distinguish, judge or appraise a person, statement, situation, or environment.
- \* In the New Testament it describes the ability to distinguish between spirits and to discern good and evil as in Hebrews 5:14.
- \* The Holy Spirit gives the gift of discernment to enable certain Christians to clearly recognize and distinguish between the influence of God, Satan, the world, and the flesh in a given situation.
- \* Separate and Investigate.

**6 For when we were still without strength, in due time

**8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that  
while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.**

**10 For if when we were enemies we were reconciled  
to God through the death of His Son, much more,  
having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His  
life.**



**11 And not only that, but we also rejoice in God  
through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we  
have now received the reconciliation.**

**Romans 5:10-11, NKJV**




**Reconciliation is an accounting process that compares two sets of records to check that figures are correct and in agreement.**

that has a deficiency or is insufficient.**


**What is Theological Reconciliation?**

life.”**



**17 Whoever is a believer in Christ is a new creation.**


**The old way of living has disappeared.**
