# Five Signs of a Faith Testimony

1. This person will live by faith (Abraham).
2. This person will live to please God (Enoch).
3. This person will live a humble life (Moses).
4. This person is willing to die for the cause of Christ (Stephen).

## Acts 7:59-60, (NLT)

59 As they stoned him, Stephen prayed,  
"Lord Jesus, receive my spirit."

60 He fell to his knees, shouting,  
"Lord, don't charge them with this sin!"
