Four Laws of a Harvest

- I. Name the Seed – Identifying
- II. Plant the Seed - Sowing
- III. Persevering - Waiting
- IV. Reaping - Celebration

Law

THE PRINCIPLE OF SEED-FAITH

Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Hebrews 11:1, NKJV

“Now faith is right now or
now unbelief is right now”



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- ✓ Every seed contains an invisible instruction.
 - ✓ We must assign or target a purpose to our seed or offering.
 - ✓ We must allow our mind to wander outside the boundaries of what is and begin to create a mental picture of what could be.
 - ✓ We should sow our seed consistently, generously and always in obedience to the voice of God.

II. Plant the Seed - Sowing

6 Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously.

7 Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

8 And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.
