



The Three D's of Satan's Weapons of Choice


1. **Deception:** the practice of deliberately making somebody believe things that are not true
2. **Deceive:** to mislead or deliberately hide the truth from somebody
3. **Deceit:** the act or practice of deceiving or misleading somebody; false impression, whether by appearance of statement

“You will not surely die.


For God knows that in the day you eat of

So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.



10 and with all unrighteous deception among those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved.



14 Seven sons of Sceva, a leading priest, were doing this.



16 Then the man with the evil spirit leaped on them, overpowered them, and attacked them with such violence that they fled from the house, naked and battered.


