The Word of God:

1. Graphe—the writing
2. Logos—the message
3. Rhema—utterance



The rhema is the declaration
of the logos that we get
from the graphe.



28 You will also declare a thing,
And it will be established for you;

say, “Exaltation will come!”

The logos not only attacks
what we do, but it also
exposes what we think.

Jesus Was Tempted Three Times By The Devil

1. "The lust of flesh" (*seeking of pleasure*)
2. "The pride of life" (*conceit and self-importance*)
3. "The lust of eyes" (*materialism, kingdoms/wealth*).



- ❑ Satan meets Jesus at the point of His problem.
- ❑ Satan is the enemy of the word of God.
- ❑ Satan's goal is to convince us to solve our problems through fleshly and Satanic means.
