# The Spiritual Law of Reciprocity.



# Reciprocity

A relationship between people involving the exchange of goods, services, favors, or obligations; a mutual exchange of privileges.



- It is the Law of Sowing and Reaping.
- It allows us to receive as a result of what we have given or done.
- It allows us to receive what we need from God in exchange for having made His kingdom our top priority.
- It is receiving from others in proportion to our generosity (Lk 6:38).
- Our giving and serving, has set spiritual forces in motion and we are getting ready to experience the results.





## Here's the beauty of this law:

If we have given or served selflessly, simply trusting God to take care of us as He thinks is appropriate, then He is free to bless us as He deems.
