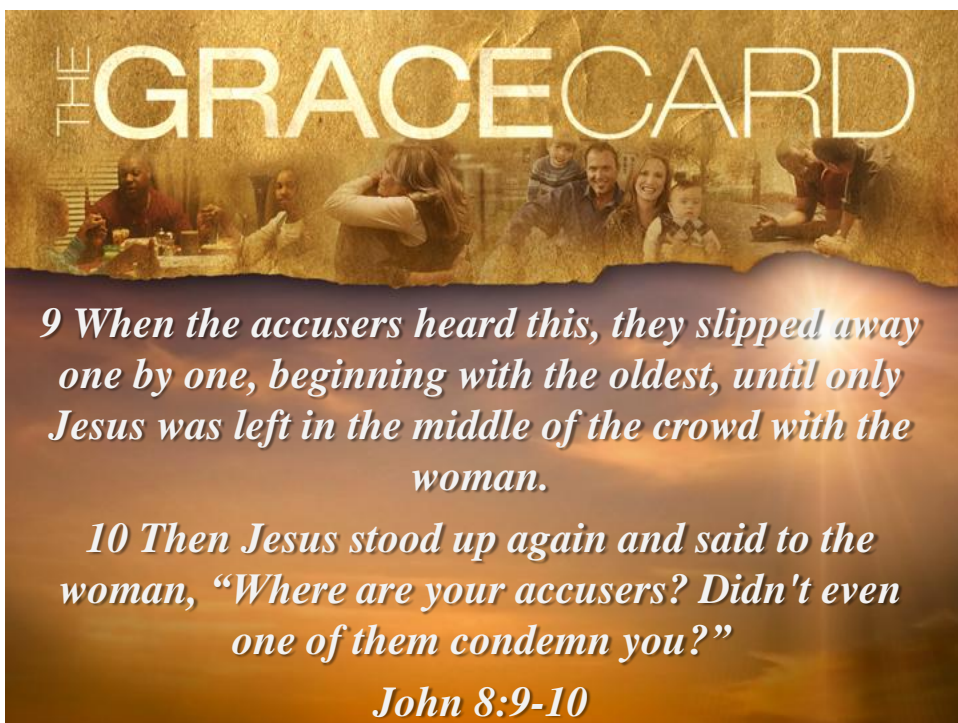
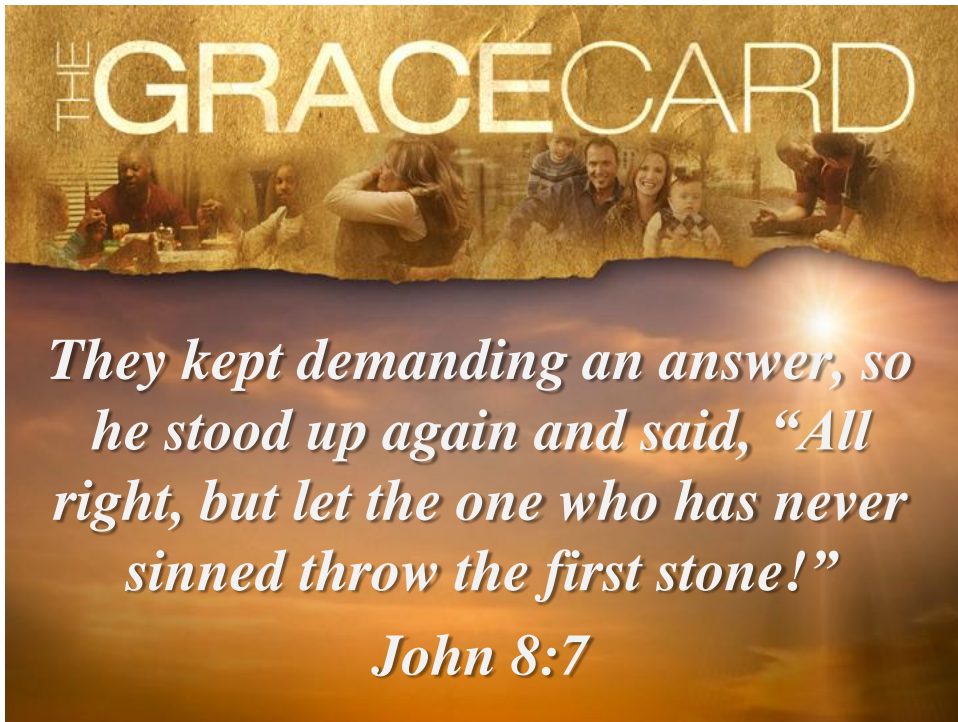


THE GRACECARD
