Point #3: Intercession for the Family

14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

15 And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

James 5:14-15, KJV

Definition:

Intercessory prayer is going to God on behalf of another, fueled by the Compassion of Jesus!

Intercessory Prayer Mandate

Waging War and Standing in the Gap Against

- 1) *Common Attacks of Sickneses ... scripture shows some illnesses have satanic origin*
- 2) *Common Attacks of Stresses ... Satan magnifies difficulties to bring destructive stresses*
- 3) *Common Attacks of Sufferings ... sufferings of loved ones is taxing on the family*

Waging War and Standing in the Gap Against

- 4) *Common Attacks of Shortages ... insufficiency often effects self worth & esteem*
- 5) *Common Attacks of Struggles ... endlessly taxing the relationship struggles*

Waging War and Standing in the Gap Against

- 6) *Common Attacks of Suicides the persuasive demonic voices can be silenced...*
- 7) *Common Attacks of Suspicions ... the unwarranted but real suspicion dart causes unrest*

*Ask the Father *Ask According to
His will *Ask in Jesus Name
* Ask with Thanksgiving*

- 1) Destiny Connections ... Waging war to establish relationship connections*
- 2) Divine Consciousness ... Waging war to believe others develop a divine consciousness*
- 3) Dispel Confusion ... Waging war to come against confusion and declare peace*

PRAYER IS A POWERFUL WEAPON

- 4) Deliverance from Calamity ...**
Waging war to believe for protection & release from evil
- 5) Discover Contentment ... Waging war and praying for the emotional well being of others**

- 6) Discerning Counsel ... Waging war praying that others will be open to godly counsel**
- 7) Demonic Cancellations ... Waging war to cancel demonic strategies**
