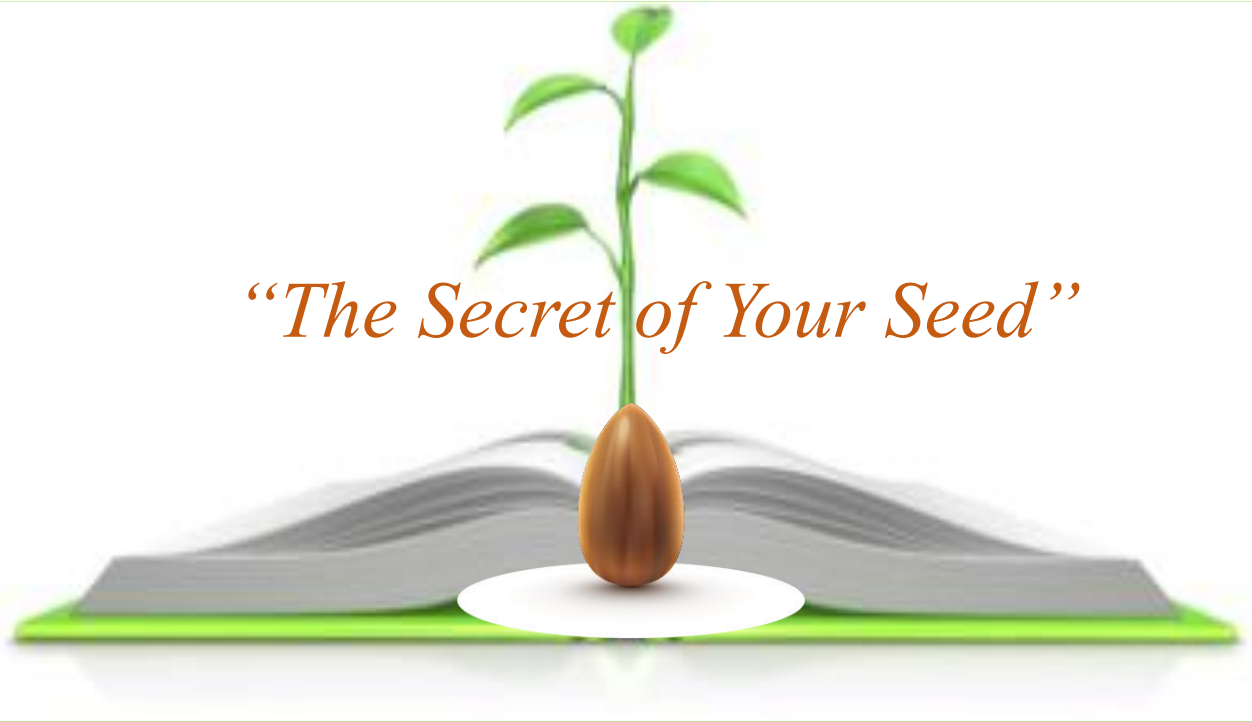

Three Laws of Planting



Number One: The Law of Immutability
